Animals may be penned from 4.00 pm on Friday 9 July, 2021 and between 7.00am and 8.00am both Saturday and Sunday. Exhibitors may choose to leave Saturday following the completion of Judging, if their animals are not required for judging on Sunday.

It is a prerequisite of this show that all exhibitors supply a completed *National South American Camelid Declaration and Waybill and Show Exhibitor Form (Covid waiver)* to the Chief Steward at the show or email to the Convenor sanddtrostian@gmail.com at least 24 hours prior to the show.

These forms will be emailed to exhibitors once their eAlpaca entries are received.

It is planned to commence judging at 8.30am both days, however this may change to a later time if entries allow.

Dress Code:

Exhibitors may choose to dress in: Full Christmas Costume, their favourite Christmas theme jumper etc or

White coat or AAA Black vest to cover any logoed black shirt. Filled in shoes are a must.

When putting your outfit together, remember it will be cold in the Pavilion.

All Exhibitors are required to wear a Christmas Theme Hat in the show ring, perhaps a Santa Hat or a Special Creation of your own; any hat sporting the Christmas theme will be acceptable.

Pens:

There is a minimum of 1 alpaca and a maximum of 3 alpacas per single pen or up to 7 alpacas to a double pen.

Triple pens are not permitted as the resulting instability of the structure can become dangerous.
